### ***Lions Receive Recognition***



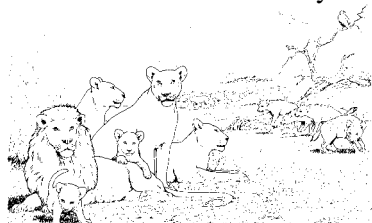
